

### Facts \*& Figures



- This steel-constructed multi-loop rollercoaster opened on 13 April 1981.
- The 750-metre-long rollercoaster can carry more than 1,400 passengers per hour along its track, which features two loops and two corkscrews.
- The two-minute ride produces a maximum g-force of 3.5 g.
- The trains were refurbished in December 2011 and two new trains were added, each with 28 seats.



- 'Joris en de Draak' is based on the legend of George and the Dragon and opened on 1 July 2010. This attraction was the first wooden racer roller coaster in north-western Europe.
- At a top speed of 75 km per hour, two teams compete against each other to slay the dragon; one representing water and the other fire.
- The four trains can carry 1,700 passengers per hour on the two-minute-long race.
- During their race passengers experience a maximum g-force of 3 g.



- This rollercoaster is called 'De Vliegende Hollander' and is based on the mystical story of The Flying Dutchman.
- This watersplash rollercoaster, which has a top speed of 70 km per hour, opened on 1 April 2007 and has a maximum g-force of 3 g.
- → It features specially designed cars in the form of a boat.
- Its 11 boats can carry 1,900 passengers per hour on the almost four-minute-long ride.



- → The spectacular dive coaster 'Baron 1898' opened on 1 July 2015.
- After hanging in mid-air, passengers plunge into a 37.5 metre free fall down a mineshaft at a top speed of 90km per hour.
- As well as the freefall, the 501-metre-long track also features a camel back and bunny hop.
- Each train can carry 18 passengers on the 130-second ride.
- The world's top DJ, Hardwell, produced a special dance mix of the theme music for Baron 1898.
